

Key Takeaways

- ❖ A well intended program can have unintended consequences - allow for flexibility and change over time to enable positive results



Questions for Reflection

1. Who are you trying to reach and serve (e.g. client personas)?
2. What needs does the community have? What solutions do they see? Are there opportunities for co-benefits?
3. How do different people receive their information?
4. What individual barriers to access do different individuals encounter (e.g. technology, language, trust, time, etc.)?
5. What systemic barriers to access do individuals encounter (e.g. large households, renting, etc.)?
6. What challenges do you foresee? And possible (negative) unintended consequences?
7. What can you leverage for greater impact (e.g. partnerships, funding, consultants, etc)?
